



Learning Log Menu- Learning Logs are given out on a Wednesday and are due in by the following Monday

The children must complete at least one **Maths** and one **English** task a term but may then choose any of the other learning log choices from the menu. As always, there are some suggestions but your child may show us their learning in any way that they choose! Thank you for your support.

1. Create a leaflet with information all about 'The Mosque'. What can be found in a mosque? What do people do in a mosque? Who leads a service in a mosque? What is the name of the holy book read in there?	2. Create a poster explaining the life cycle of a plant. How do they reproduce? Include the following key words: germination, pollination, fertilisation and seed dispersal.	3. Write a formal letter of complaint to the captain of the Titanic. Explain what the problem is and why it is unacceptable. What do you expect the captain to do to make this better? (Let's see lots of writing skills being used)
4. Write a short diary entry about a day on the Titanic.	5. Write a step by step guide on how to multiply large numbers together. (2 digit number multiplied by 2 digit number) Give examples throughout.	6. Choose a place that you like to go to in Milton Keynes. (Stadium MK, Xscape, Willen Lake etc.) Can you write about the history of that place? When was it built? Use the internet/ books for research.
7. Think about your favourite place in Milton Keynes. Write a 'persuasive' piece of writing about that place so that other people will want to visit it.	8. In Art this half term, we are going to be sketching the local environment. Sit near a window in your house and sketch what you can see outside. (Pencil only)	9. Log in to My Maths or TT Rockstars and have a play!

Task	Information
Reading	School reading records to be signed by a parent to indicate books/chapters/pages read a minimum of 3 times a week.
Weekly Spellings	Published in reading record books every week for a test on Friday.
